BOOKING A CRAFT VISIT

All the craft activities in this booklet can be brought out to affiliated groups and run as an activity for everyone.

Prices range between 20p and 50p per item. In order to encourage more members to take part it is recommended, where possible, that the club covers the cost of each member's first item, with members paying for additional items themselves.

As a charity we also ask you consider making a small discretionary £5 donation towards travel expenses.

At the session, it would be helpful to gather all the group together for an initial demonstration, which takes about two minutes, since even those members who don't want to take part at the start often change their minds when they see other members work. This saves time by not having to repeat everything several times.

PLASTER CAST MODEL PAINTING

£0.35 per item



This activity involves the painting of plaster models which can be chosen from a range of pre-made plaster casts brought to your club, and are ready to be painted straight away. The models will be mainly animals and birds, which are always popular with groups.

KITE MAKING

£0.50 per item



This is a brilliant activity for the lighter evenings and the kites fly extremely well in the slightest breeze. They are made with coloured polythene and sticks, and can be made and flown on the same evening, weather permitting. They can also be decorated if desired.

SCRATCH ART



£0.35 per item

This craft uses specially produced card over which a picture is placed, it is then scored to make an indentation to transfer the outline of the picture onto the card. The black surface of the card is then scratched away to reveal either multi-coloured or holographic effects underneath. The pictures are mounted onto white card, which looks really great.

GLASS PAINTING



£0.45 per item

Another extremely popular craft. This involves copying/drawing designs onto glass (or a glass substitute) using a tube of black outliner. The outlines are then filled in with transparent glass paint. Sticky tabs are then added so that the pieces can be attached to a window or mirror, where they catch the light.

HAMA BEADS



£0.30 per item

This activity creates coaster size patterns and pictures by placing various different coloured tubular shaped beads onto a plastic pegboard and arranging them into a chosen design. These are then ironed which sticks the beads together. The finished shapes can then be used in a variety of decorative and practical ways.

SCRATCH LIGHT



£0.45 per item

This is a great craft, using specially produced multi-coloured acetate with a black covering, which is scraped away through stencils with small tools. Although similar to scratch art, it is also quite different since when the acetates are placed near a window or other light source, their transparency shows all the vivid colours.

MAGIC MAIZE



£0.35 per item

This is an amazing craft where you can make both collage pictures and free standing models by sticking noodles together using water. This is a fun novelty craft and the possibilities are endless.

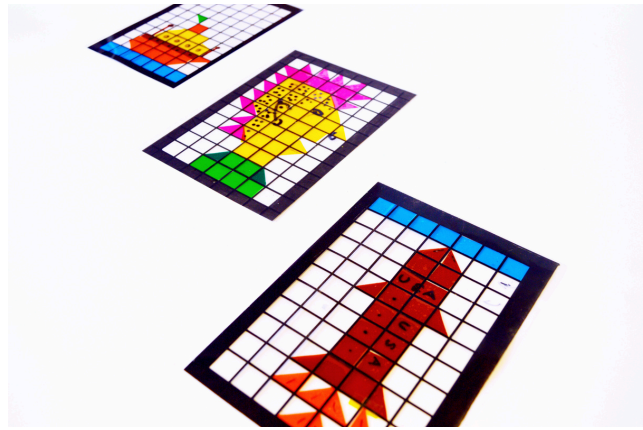
SAND ART BRACELETS



£0.30 per item

In great demand. These are tubular bracelets filled with layers of different coloured sands in any combination with push-in stoppers.

WINDOW CLING MOSAICS



£0.30 per item

This is a craft which involves making transparent mosaics with special plastic on an acetate grid. The coloured plastic is pre-cut into squares which, because they are made of special clingy plastic, will stick to both acetate and glass without either glue or tape. Stencils are placed behind the acetate grid which are then copied by placing coloured squares onto the acetate to build up the picture.

PYROGRAPHY



£0.35 per item

Otherwise known as wood burning, this is a great activity for older age groups. It involves drawing a design on cork either by stencil or free-hand, and then burning the design on with a special pyrography iron. This activity is fully supervised at all times to ensure a safe fun session for your group.

QUILLING



£0.20 per item

Traditional style collage craft where thin strips of coloured machine produced paper are curled into a variety of different shapes and stuck onto a background. You can make either very simple or extremely intricate designs with this craft.

SILHOUETTE SUN CATCHERS



£0.30 per item

This is a new silhouette craft using pre-cut black shapes arranged on acetate and covered with sticky backed plastic and to add colour, small pieces of window cling are added to the back of the picture. A suction cup is added so the sun catcher can be stuck on a window. Very striking!

SHRINKITS



£0.35 per item

Very popular craft. This is all about making key rings by copying ready-made or own designs onto sheet plastic which are then cut out, hole-punched and shrunk to a quarter of their original size in an oven. The shape is then attached to a key ring.

EARRING MAKING



£0.35 per pair

These are dangling earrings for pierced ears only, although clip-on attachments (not supplied) can be used instead. The earrings are made by threading a wide variety of beads onto headpins which are then attached to kidney wires.

GLASS ENGRAVING

£0.45 per item



Designs are scratched onto glass substitute using a diamond tipped pen. The image can either be traced from a picture or drawn free-hand from the imagination. The engraving is completed by rubbing silver metallic paste into the image, which greatly enhances the finished result. These are then attached to a black background.

EGG SCULPTURES

£0.40 per item



With this craft you can make cute animals and people out of polystyrene eggs and balls. These can then be decorated with pipe cleaners, paint and foam shapes to create really cool free standing models that the kids will love.

ZOTE FOAM



£0.35 per item

These are coloured foam shapes that are cut with a hot knife after the design is first drawn in pen from a wide range of templates. A suction cup is then added so that the finished design can be attached to a window or fridge etc.

SCULPEY CLAY



£0.35 per item

This is an amazing material that resembles plasticine and stays soft, but unlike plasticine bakes hard like clay in a domestic oven over 15 minutes. This makes it brilliant for making small models which can then be coloured with felt tip pens.

WIRE SCULPTURES

£0.30 per item

Very bendy wire is pressed into grooved picture blocks which when removed take on the image of the picture. The resulting wire sculpture is then attached to a black card which can then be decorated with a white pen, after which a stand is added. These have proved very popular.



FOIL EMBOSSING

£0.40 per item

Traced pictures are placed over coloured foil, which is then placed over a plastic circle. The traced design is then drawn over with a heated pen which leaves an image of the design in foil on the plastic disc, which is then given a backing and turns into a fridge magnet.



FOIL PRESSING



£0.50 per item

Squares of gold, silver or copper foil are attached onto raised plastic moulds and pressed with a tool to create three dimensional pictures. The image can then be rubbed with black paint to give it an old look, or painted with a brush in the normal way using poster paint.

SAND ART PICTURES



£0.50 per item

These are specially produced cards with a wide variety of designs on them. Starting with the smallest, each shape is lifted off one at a time revealing a sticky backed area onto which coloured sand is sprinkled. This is continued until the whole picture is finished, and completely covered with different coloured sand. Great fun to do.

EMBOSSING



£0.35 per item

This craft uses a wide range of rubber stamps pressed onto a transparent ink pad. The image is then stamped onto paper sprinkled with embossing powder and held under a heat gun to create a glossy image. They make great mobiles.
