C1 | Malteser Games

A selection of games involving the popular chocolate balls. Activities include Malteser Maze and Malteser Run.

Group to provide a box of Maltesers.



C2 | Pioneering

A selection of activities relating to pioneering. It can also be used as part of the Pioneer Badge in Scouting.



C3 | Balloon Modelling

A fun activity shaping balloons into different shapes. Can be used as a craft session on its own or in conjunction with Circus Skills, unicycle and clown kit to form a bigger circus themed event.

Works well with C4 Circus Skills.



C4 | Circus Skills

A variety of circus skills equipment to enjoy at your group. Learn the skills of the circus including: juggling, diabolo, hoops, stilts, hoop spinning, plate spinning and more.

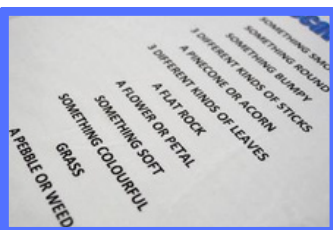
Works well with C3 Balloon Modelling.



C7 | Face Paints

Be creative with face paints. A fun activity especially for younger children, great at fetes and parties. It also links well with the circus activities.

Pack includes various colours and some ideas of face creations.



C8 | Scavenger Hunt

Find the random objects.



C10 | Bubbles Kit

Have fun making giant bubbles. Pack includes bubble rings, and Dr Zigs bubble solution.

C11 | Balloon Cars

Make self-propelling cars, and then race them. A fun activity for all.

C12 | Egg Crash

Build a structure to protect an egg falling from a great height.

Create your own sock puppet. Box contains everything you will need to create a great puppet.

C14 | Stress Balls

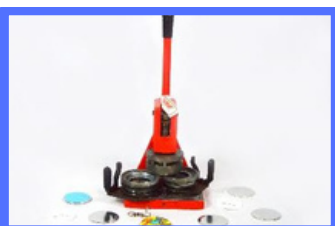
Make your own stress balls. A great creative activity which is also great for mindfulness and a good starting point to mental health discussions.

Have fun designing your own badges.

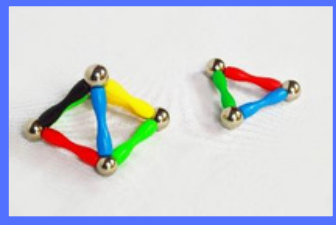
We charge £5 per 25 badges.

G1 | Balloon Rugby

A simple game based on Rugby.



G2 | Bean Bag Games

A selection of games involving bean bags.



G3 | Bucket Ball

A high-octane game. Pass the ball and score a goal in the bucket.



G4 | Jump the Rope

High-energy game to jump over a moving rope.



G5 | Land Mines

Teams have to navigate a blindfolded member across a minefield of plastic cups.



G6 | Six is the Number

Roll a 6 to take a turn at eating a bar of chocolate with a knife and fork.

Group to provide a bar of chocolate.



G7 | Lego Wars

Team game - two teams compete to build an identical replica of the Lego model.



G8 | Paper Games

A selection of activities using newspapers.
Games include Paper Towers & Newspaper Fashion.



G9 | Memory Game

Remember a series of items on a tray.



G10 | Skittle Ball & Bowling

Skittle ball is a game which involves knocking down skittles at either end of a dodgeball court. 10 pin bowling is where you knock down as many skittles as possible.



G11 | Water Games

A selection of games involving water.
Games include Fire Sponge Ball, Sponge Relay, Soap Netball, Water Gun Cup, Water Duck Duck Goose, Sponge Wars.



G12 | Water Pipe

Get the ping-pong ball to the top of the
Work together to fill the pipe and raise the ping pong ball to the top — sounds simple, right? The challenge? The pipe is full of holes, so teamwork and quick thinking are a must as you plug the leaks and pour in water. It's messy, fun, and a great test of collaboration!



G13 | Mop Hockey

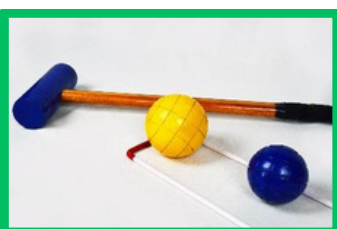
A fun wet game. Score a goal on a soapy tarpaulin.

G14 | Tug of War

Age old game of strength with two opposing teams pulling either end of a length of rope.



G15 | Croquet

Age old garden game involving hitting heavy balls through hoops with a mallet.



G16 & G17 | Small and Large Parachute

Enjoy the many parachute games. Those include: Cat and Mouse, Catch the Fish, How High Can You Go, Mushroom, Popcorn, Sharks, Sock Shuffle, Under the Shute, Dog Cat & Mouse, and Will It Be You?



G18 | Inflatable Target Ball

This is a simple game much like archery or darts, the object being to score more points than your opponent.



G19 | Human Hungry Hippos

A large team game based on the board game. Teams have to push a team member on a wheeled board into the centre of the room to collect small balls in a basket.

This activity is staff led only - please book as an activity visit.



G20 | Kubb Viking Chess

A fun garden game involving knocking blocks over with batons.



G21 | 60 Second Challenges

A series of quick games and challenges to be completed in under a minute. Games include: Elephant Walk, Apple Stack, Biscuit Slide, Cross-Eye Dice Stack, Balloon Cup Blow, Pasta Challenge, Stacking Cups.

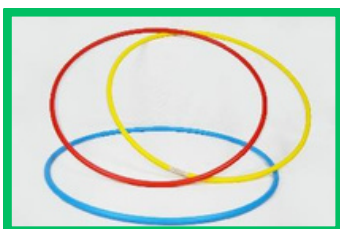
There is a £2 charge for this activity.

G23 | Pipe Games

This is a fun game aimed at getting participants to work together. There are two variations, the wet variation is better played outdoors in fine weather. This activity can also be used to develop leadership skills. It can be played as a challenge activity with one group of people or as a competitive game with two groups (there are enough pipes so that each team can have the same number of the same lengths).



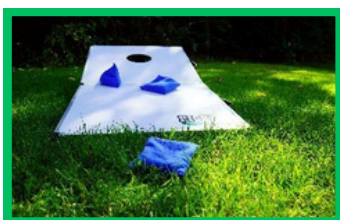
G24 | Hoops

2 sizes.



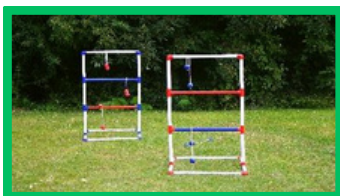
G25 | Flipper Run

Two teams throw beanbags into the hole.



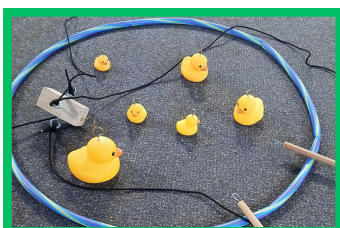
G27 | Ladder Golf

A throwing game – throw the stringed golf ball onto the ladder.



G28 | Capture the Flag

Popular wide game.



G30 | Hook-a-duck

Based on the fun fair game this activity is ideal for developing teamwork and leadership with the addition of blindfolds and a hook attached to ropes. The game also comes with a paddling pool and rods for a more traditional fun game. Book with a hoop from G24 if needed.



G31 | Ski Walk

A fun team building game. Work together to walk in teams.

S1 | Dodgeball

An indoor team game for teams of 3 or more.



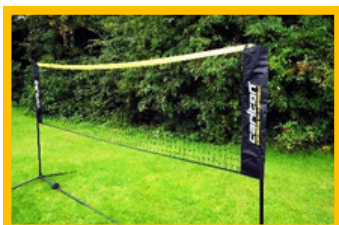
S2 | Tag Rugby / Tag belts

Tag rugby is a non-contact version of rugby, in which each player wears a special belt that has two tags attached to it. Instead of being tackled, a player carrying the ball can be 'tagged' by having a tag removed from their belt by a member of the opposition.



S3 | Unihoc

A fun team game based on hockey.



S4 | Volleyball

A team game for 4 players or more.



S5 | Curling

A version of the winter Olympic sport which can be played anywhere.

Two versions of the game with a traditional target mat and a numbers mat.



S6 | Curling Ramp

A slide to make S5 Curling accessible to anyone.

S7 | Archery

Popular sport with bows and arrows. Set includes suction arrows making this a safe way to bring archery indoors.



S8 | Boccia

A Paralympic sport based on bowls - an indoor game which anyone can play.



S9 | Spikeball

A fun high-octane sport for 2-6 players.



S10 | Goal Ball & Blind Football

Two popular Paralympic sports which are fun for anyone. (1) Goal Ball: a game of throwing a ball with bells into the opponent's goal whilst blindfolded. (2) Blind Football: using only hearing, opponents have to kick the ball into the opponent's goal.



S12 | Pop-up Goals

Multi-purpose goals for a variety of sports.



S13 | Boules

Traditional garden sport.



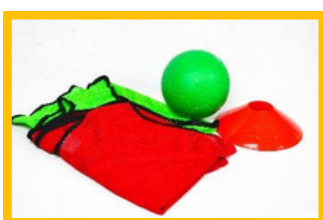
S14 | Softball

Softball is a variant of baseball played with a larger ball.



S15 | Lacrosse

Lacrosse is a team sport played with lacrosse sticks and a lacrosse ball, commonly played indoors or outdoors.



S16 | Handball

Handball is a team sport in which two teams of seven players each pass a ball using their hands with the aim of throwing it into the goal of the other team.



S19 | Rounders

Rounders is a striking and fielding team game that involves hitting a small, hard, leather-cased ball with a round-ended wooden, plastic or metal bat. The players score by running around the four bases on the field.



S20 | Kwik Cricket

A fast paced version of cricket.



S22 | Cones

A large selection of coloured cones.



S24 | Tchoukball

Tchoukball is a mixed-gender, non-contact sport. A great catch and throw team game, great for hand-eye coordination and development. Suitable for all abilities.



S25 | Kin-Ball

Kin-Ball is a dynamic and versatile sport that can be enjoyed both indoors and outdoors, with three teams competing in each game. Central to the sport is the Omnikin ball, a large inflatable ball about 1 meter tall.



S26 | Mini Disc Golf

This compact version of the popular outdoor sport is great for team-building or just a bit of friendly competition. Easy to set up indoors or outdoors, the set includes a vibrant target with chains and multiple coloured discs. It is fun, accessible, and always entertaining.
